Summary of 2024 ANAC bylaw changes proposed:

Nominating Committee:

1. Committee Make-up: Remains 5 members Rather than 100% member elected

Vote:

- Option A: 100% BOD appointed; Term: Two year & eligible for another 2-year reappointment by the Board of Directors
- Option B: Hybrid 2/5 Member elected and 3/5 BOD appointed; Term: Two year & eligible for either re-election by membership (2/5) &/or another 2-year reappointment by the Board of Directors (3/5)
- Abstain

2. Committee Chair

Rather than person with most votes becomes Committee Chair Vote:

- Option A: Immediate Past President appointed by current BOD
- Option B: Member of Immediate Past BOD appointed (could include past President) by current BOD
- Abstain
- 3. Duties: New additional language
- 1. Within a reasonable time prior to BOD elections, the Nominating Committee will receive BOD assessment & gap analysis & notice of upcoming vacancies from the ANAC BOD Secretary.
- 2. The Nominating Committee will seek to identify qualified candidates for nomination that match the ANAC BOD identified gaps.
- 3. The Nominating Committee will issue a call to ANAC members for nominations to all available BOD open spots.

Vote:

- Accept new language
- o Reject new language
- Abstain

Note: BOD membership still decided by elections via majority general membership vote.

Making amendments to Bylaws:

Allow for bylaws change up to twice/year. Current language restricts to once/per year Vote:

- Option One: Bylaws amendments approved by majority vote of BOD. Bylaws may be changed up to twice a year.
- Option Two: Bylaws amendments approved by majority of voting members.
 Bylaws may be changed up to twice a year.
- Abstain
